Terms and Conditions

Information and Conditions of Booking

The main restaurant seats up to 72 people and links with the Georgian room, which seats up to 16 people. Private facilities for parties of 60 people or more may be arranged with or without a disco. If numbers subsequently fall below 60 people, Lysses House reserves the right to take additional bookings. All Christmas events include crackers and novelties.

How to Book

- Decide on a date and telephone us for availability. If the date you require is free we will provisionally book your table.
- Complete the booking form on page 13 and return it to us, along with the deposit, as soon as possible.
- All bookings are subject to written confirmation and will only be treated as confirmed when the deposit and the booking form have been received.
- **Deposits are due by October 1st or within 14 days of making the booking. If the deposit is not received Lysses House reserves the right to release the booking, although we will always try and contact you first.**
- **Deposits are non-refundable and non transferable.**

Please ensure all members of your party are aware of the terms and conditions.

- When the deposits have been received, we will send you a form to complete your menu choices. When you return this to us we will complete name cards on your behalf. If your party is below 10 (or 6 on New Years Eve) you do not need to pre-order. However, if you wish to choose on the day please be prepared for a slightly longer service.
- **If your party is below 10 the balance can be paid on the day. If your party is 10 or more, payment in full is required at least 14 days before your function. This is to avoid confusion and allows our restaurant staff to concentrate on service, rather than billing.**
- Accounts may only be sent to your company if credit facilities have been arranged in advance.

Additions

Small additions to numbers may be possible at the discretion of the Restaurant Manager at least 24 hours in advance.

Cancellation

We regret that deposits are not refundable or transferable. For parties of 10 or more, any cancellations or reductions in numbers made after 10pm the day before your function will be charged in full. A refund of the amount paid less the deposit will be made for cancellations made before this time.

Please ensure all members of your party are aware of the terms and conditions.

Cancellation by the Hotel

In the event that the hotel has to cancel any booking, an alternative date or venue will be offered or a full refund given.

Your Responsibilities:

- * Any damage caused to the hotel, fixtures or fittings is the responsibility of the party organiser and will result in a charge to remedy such damage. This includes any costs we incur to clean an area.
- * Any behaviour which our staff deems to be disruptive to other parties may result in members of your party being asked to leave the premises.
- * Only food and drink purchased at Lysses may be consumed on the premises.
- * Children under the age of 14 are not permitted at Open Party Nights without prior permission from the management
- * Presentations, raffles, quizzes and speeches cannot always be accommodated. Please check with a member of staff.

Billing

Any extras will be billed at the end of your meal. Your party will receive one bill to save time and confusion. Please let us know prior to the event if you require a VAT invoice.

Privacy

Our privacy policy is available on our website and sets out the terms by which we process any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us.

General

The hotel reserves the right to alter, amend or change any of the content, menus or prices within this brochure, should circumstances demand.

Lysses House cannot accept responsibility for loss or damage to customers' property unless the loss or damage can be proved to have been caused by the negligence, wilful act or default of management or its employees.

Cloakrooms are not secure and notices to that effect are in clear view.

All prices quoted are inclusive of VAT at the current rate.

Service is discretionary.

If there are any corona virus restrictions in place that mean your booking cannot go ahead, we will change the date of your booking, or if this is not possible, refund any monies paid (including deposits).

These terms and conditions are subject to the laws of England.

- large wine /drink orders

Direct Deposit Payments

If you are the organiser of a Christmas party, we understand how much work is involved.

One of the biggest challenges you face is the collection of deposits and final payments, as many people do not carry cash or cheque books with them. There is also the added problem of storing the money safely and securely until you can pop into the hotel.

Our aim is to make to your life easier.

Members of your party can call us with their credit or debit card details and pay for their deposit / final payment direct. We will also accept cash and cheques direct.

They will need to provide the following information:

Date and time of booking

Name of the booking.

Name

Amount of deposit / final payment they wish to pay.

How it works

We will keep a list of everyone in your party who has paid, along with the amount they have paid.

We will not send receipts to individual people, but periodically send them to the party organiser, along with a list of who has paid.

It is the responsibility of the party organiser to remind any members of their party who have not paid their deposit.

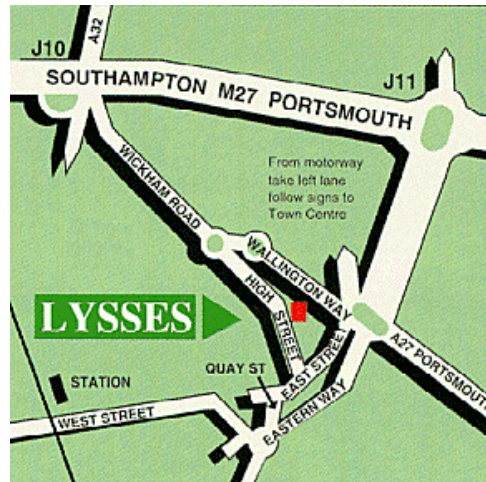
